The “Manor,” in partnership with the U. S. Dept. of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), provides subsidized housing for the elderly and disabled (with mobility impairment).

Head of household must be at least 62 years of age to qualify or at least 18 years of age if disabled.

Income limitations apply.

Service Coordination

Our goal is to see our residents successfully remain in their home by “aging in place.”

The Service Coordinator assists our residents by linking them to supportive services available in the community.



Service Coordination Resource Library

Although we do not provide any direct services, we encourage residents to maintain their independence by taking advantage of community resources to meet any unmet needs (i.e. Housekeeping, transportation, etc.).

“Staying Fit” Nutrition Program

The United Church Manor is one of Erie County’s dining sites for the elderly. A nutritious, well balanced meal is served Monday through Friday at 12:15 pm.

Who can qualify? Age is the only eligibility requirement. You must be at least 60 years of age or married to someone who is.

How much will the meal cost? A \$3.00 donation per meal is requested. If you are unable to donate that amount, you may donate whatever you can afford.

Why should I attend? In addition to good food, there will be companionship with people who share similar interests. Many friendships form between our residents and those who live in the neighboring community at large.

Note: You do not need to be a resident of “The MANOR” to attend the meal program.
